Moisturize for the entire week before your session. Use a heavy moisturizer on your hands, cuticles and nails to help heal any cracked skin or broken nail beds.

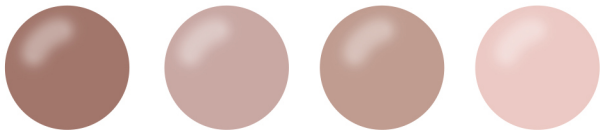
DON'T FORGET YOUR TOENAILS

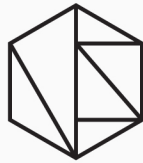
Especially if you're going to show off your toes in peep toe heels or sandals. Remember to keep your toenails perfectly pampered with a professional pedicure.
